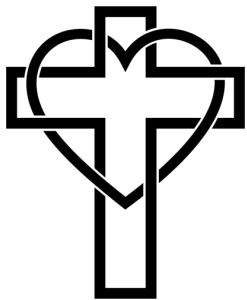


Drop Off and Pick Up Procedure



- All children in grades 1-5 should be escorted to their classroom and picked up from their classroom by a parent or authorized adult.
- When picking up and dropping off students, please enter using the Dug-out door and when leaving exit the building at the other end of the hallway.
- All teens in grades 6-9 should enter and exit the Dug-Out door.
- Parents may wait for their children in the social room until the end of class.



Parking



- Parking is available in the MARKED SPACES only.
- Do NOT park in the fire lanes or in the driveway blocking traffic.
- DRIVE SLOWLY AND USE CAUTION! There are children entering and exiting vehicles and walking through the parking areas.

Tasks of Faith Formation

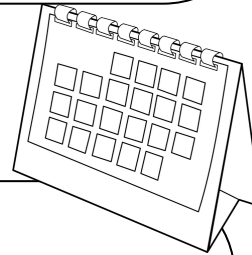

Parents have the primary responsibility for the education of their children.

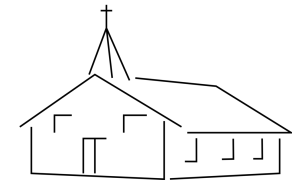
- Create a home of tenderness, forgiveness, and respect.
